Kim Storey, EdD, is a developmental psychologist and educator who focuses on the healthy development of children and families. She has developed, designed, written, and produced many highly acclaimed educational resources for children, parents, and educators. These resources include television programs, videos, websites, toolkits, guidebooks, and educational programs. She is a consultant to educators, media companies, and professional organizations. She also frequently serves as a featured speaker and conducts workshops throughout the country and internationally.

Dr. Storey applies child development principles, educational objectives, content expertise, and research-based strategies to ensure that projects and programs are educationally sound and developmentally appropriate for their target audiences. Her content expertise includes bullying and violence prevention, science education, social-emotional development, and media effects on children.

As a bullying prevention educator, Dr. Storey has created [Eyes on Bullying](#), [Eyes on Bullying in Early Childhood](#), [Eyes on Bullying: What You Can Do to Prevent and Stop Bullying at Camp](#) and [Bullying Prevention: A Guide for Grandparents](#). She also regularly [blogs](#) about bullying prevention. Most recently, she helped to develop [BOSTON vs BULLIES](#), The Sports Museum's anti-bullying initiative, which includes public service announcements, an educational video, facilitator's guides, a website, student programs, teacher training, and community outreach.

As a Senior Scientist at Education Development Center (EDC), Dr. Storey contributed to strategic planning, writing, research, and website development for bullying prevention. She led a partnership between EDC and the Boston Public Schools to enhance bullying prevention education, with a focus on serving students with disabilities. The initiative included workshops, [guides](#), online professional development courses, and the *Saturdays for Success* bullying intervention student program.

Dr. Storey served as Interim Project Director for The Newton Partnership (federally-funded by the Safe Schools/Healthy Students Initiative), where she managed a community-wide project to foster safe, respectful, and bullying-free school environments.

Other multimedia educational resources created by Dr. Storey include: (1) Parent and teacher websites and materials for the national PBS preschool science series [The Cat in the Hat Knows a Lot About That!](#) and (2) Educational objectives, content, and production concepts for [Baby Abuelita Productions](#), a bilingual television and DVD series for preschoolers promoting Hispanic culture, language development in English and Spanish, and positive social-emotional growth.

While serving for nearly ten years as the Director of Educational Research at the WGBH Educational Foundation, Dr. Storey developed and managed educational television, video, technology, and print projects. She was Project Director for *Discovering Psychology*, a 26-part television course on introductory psychology, and Project Director for a five-year Harvard Educational Technology Center initiative researching the impact of new technologies for teaching science in schools. Dr. Storey has also served as a consultant to Children's Television Workshop as a researcher for *Sesame Street*, *The Electric Company*, and *3-2-1 Contact*.
